TEXO is a proud sponsor of Aberdeen FC. As front-of-shirt sponsors, TEXO has free tickets to every game. These are given to Archie's for families who have been affected by illness; ticketholders get a VIP experience which creates lots of special memories.

Since sponsoring Aberdeen, TEXO has also signed a sponsorship with Blyth Spartans – the historic local team based near our site in Port of Blyth. The Spartans occupy an important role at the very heart of the local community, which is a key reason for TEXO's sponsorship, regardless of their position in the league. *"We're committed, they're committed,"* says Alan.

In Witham, where TEXO DSI is based, director Lauren Arnott has been exploring opportunities for local sponsorship and support. The Foundation has become a sponsor for Witham Cricket club, producing banners for the ground and drone footage for marketing purposes.

The TEXO Foundation has also just announced sponsorship of Witham Town FC, which has achieved permission for plans to build a 7-a-side 3G pitch. The Foundation will provide support for social media, enabling the club to reach more fans and build buzz around the latest developments.

For TEXO it's not really about brand advertising; it's about fuelling community spirit.

The Foundation's support is valuable and we want to continue channelling it out to the community, especially during the cost of living crisis – like food, clothes, and opportunities for children whose parents can't afford it," says Lauren.

What's next?

Former AFC captain, Russell Anderson, has established his own foundation which has enabled thousands of kids to attend sporting camps and benefit from specialist coaching. He's in conversation with TEXO MD Chris Smith about a big idea: "sports banks" which would provide trainers and kit to young people who wouldn't otherwise have the right gear to train.

With the Foundation we want to bring more than just money – we have the manpower and the resources to build solutions in communities where they'll make a huge difference," explained Chris. "I've been talking to Russell about bringing this idea to life and we're keen to make it happen."

TEXO SPONSORS SUPERCAR DAY IN THE SHIRE

TEXO is sponsoring Supercar Day in the Shire, an event especially for families affected by chronic and terminal illness.

On Sunday 13th August, at least 25 children and young people will meet up with supercar drivers for breakfast at TEXO before setting out in convoy to the Grampian Transport Museum. The kids will get into the passenger seats – and feel like superstars for the morning.

In the Museum grounds, 400+ invited families will be welcomed by the array of supercars (including Ferraris, Lamborghinis, Porsches, McLarens, and some vintage models) – plus face-painting, bouncy castle, food, and Superhero meet-and-greets. It's not a fundraiser, but an experience: this event is invite-only. The idea is to provide a fun, memorable day for families with a parent or child diagnosed with a chronic or terminal illness. Last held in 2019 and put on pause during the pandemic, the Supercar Day in the Shire is returning for its fourth year in 2023.

Since becoming involved with Emily and the supercar day in 2019 we've all been waiting for the opportunity to host again and support the whole day," says Richard Lamb (Director of Workplace Solutions at TEXO). "Watching the cars leave the site is very moving – it breaks all our hearts. Emily puts everything into it and here at TEXO we all feel committed to providing support and ensuring the families have the best day they can possibly have."

The Story behind Supercar Day

Emily was 14 when she was diagnosed with Neuroblastoma, a rare form of cancer for her age, affecting the nervous system.



In 2014, while I was going through treatment, my brother Max and I attended a supercar day at the Grampian Transport Museum and we absolutely loved it," she explains. "I'd always loved cars, but this event sparked my passion for supercars. Max was 6 years old, and his face just lit up when he got a ride in the cars. I remember we were both obsessed with the Audi R8s."

Siblings are affected massively when their brother or sister is unwell, and I think it is so important to give an opportunity for them to have fun and experience something really special – of course this event is for the whole family."

Inspired by her own experiences, Emily founded Supercar Day in the Shire. She wanted to give families a 'day off' from thinking about illness and appointments. "We go above and beyond to make our event as memorable as possible," she said. "I know what a strain a chronic or terminal illness can have on families." Tickets are given out by designated charities including The Archie Foundation, Charlie House, Friends of Anchor, and Maggie's Aberdeen. "So far, we have given out 400+ tickets to 12 local charities. We have so many families that are so excited for the event. I just want to do everything I can to make the day incredibly special for them."


